Students opting to enroll in the History sequence must also complete an approved three credit Literature course. **If students take two history courses and one literature course, one ADDITIONAL literature, humanities or fine arts course is required to satisfy the 12 hour humanities core requirement.**

Area III: Natural Science

You'll need 8 semester hours of science courses including 2 hours of laboratory experience (or the equivalent) and 3 semester hours of mathematics at the precalculus algebra level or higher.
