



# UA Online RN to BSN Concurrent Enrollment

Upon successful completion of two semesters of their Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) program, students may enroll in a BSN course as early as the third, fourth or fifth semester of their ADN program. All RN Mobility prerequisites must be complete. A letter of recommendation from the ADN program is required.
